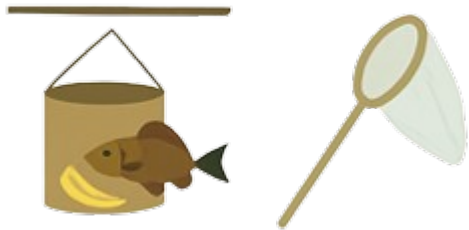


# Daytime butterflies in RNCE Uruki El Manantial Florencia (Colombia)

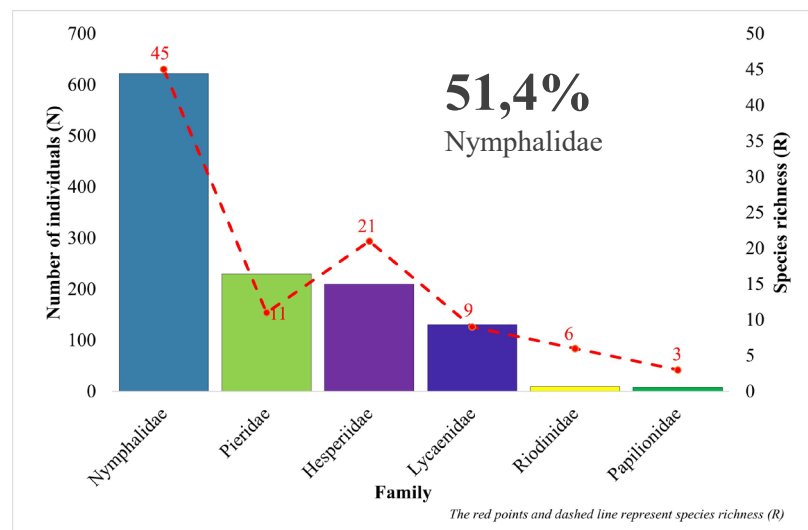


The reserve comprises 45 ha of tropical humid forest, at 490 m a.s.l., where 80% corresponds to secondary forest and pastures



15 days · 10 stations · Passive: Van Someren-Rydon traps (fruit/fish) · Active: entomological net

## Results



95 species 1210 Individuals

## Analysis



**Dominant species:** *Hermeuptychia hermes* (28.4%). *Eurema daira* and *Anartia jatrophae* (17%). Indicators of disturbed ecosystems.



**Conservation indicator species:** *Morpho achilles*, *Callicore cynosura*, *Archaeoprepona demophon*, *Kolana ligurina*, *Bungalotis milleri* (7.3%). Associated with conserved forests and ecotourism value.



**Key finding:** 54.7% of species were rare or uncommon.

In **conclusion**, the reserve functions as a **refuge** for diversity and a space for **ecological connectivity** between the forest and the human environment.
